


TRAFFIC







Centennial Airport:


Centennial Airport is a public use airport located in Dove Valley, owned by the Arapahoe County Public Airport Authority, 15 nautical miles southeast of downtown Denver, Colorado.

The airport opened on May 12, 1968, as Arapahoe County Airport, and was renamed on July 13, 1984. In 1985 a new control tower was built. It is an international airport with continuous U.S. Customs services and is one of the busiest general aviation airports in the United States with an average of 874 operations per day and covers 1,400 acres at an elevation of 5,885 feet. It has three asphalt runways. Key Lime Air has its corporate headquarters on the airport property.

Wings Over the Rockies' Exploration of Flight is a unique to the nation attraction on a 15-acre campus located on the south side of Centennial Airport. The 19,000-square-foot Boeing Blue Sky Aviation Gallery is broken up into two experience arenas. The first floor covers the "experience" of flight and in the second level, visitors will understand the "sequence" of flight.

Business Park 50 (BP50) District

The Business Park 50 (BP50) District allows for the development of office and enclosed light industrial uses in a campus-like setting. This environment may also include residential uses that are closely related to office, medical, and commercial use, such as live-work units, assisted living facilities, congregate care facilities, and nursing homes.
